HOW TO TRANSPORT THESE MATERIALS SAFELY:

- DO Leave materials in original, labeled containers. Tighten caps & lids.
- DO Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- DO Sort & pack separately: paint, pesticides, household cleaners.
- DO Pack your car and drive directly to site.

If you're unable to make the 6/4 date, see DPW web site for neighboring town's HHW dates or go to CT DEP web site

There is no direct cost to you for bringing in waste, however, there is a cost to the Town per car. Please consolidate waste with neighbors, if possible.

This collection is operated by Care Environmental who reserves the right to refuse unidentified material and large amounts of hazardous waste. For quantities in excess of 25 gallons or for any other questions regarding the collection, please call Town of Darien, Dept. of Public Works (656-7346).

There ***will be*** a mercury thermometer trade-in this year while supplies last. Bring yours to turn in and receive a digital replacement. Remember a gram of mercury (~ the amt. in a thermometer) can contaminate a 20 acre lake for a year.
