Computer Recycling - Limited Electronics Recycling now available.

The Town of Darien has begun a limited computer electronics recycling program at the Darien Transfer Station at 126 Ledge Road. Disposing of electronic waste is available for all those having access privileges to the Darien Transfer Station. You must have a valid RDA (aka dump) sticker or commercial permit to access the transfer station. Persons disposing of acceptable electronics waste will not be charged. Acceptable electronics will be put in a container located near the residential recycling area (near the building).

Acceptable electronics waste is defined as: computers; computer monitors (crt or non-crt); keyboards; mice; printers; external disc drives; and computer cables.

Non acceptable electronic items are: televisions of any type; motor vehicle electronics (including car radios); stereos; speakers; electronics that are part of a larger unit; washing machines; dryers; dishwashers; medical or diagnostic devices; refrigerators; ovens; air conditioners; dehumidifiers; freezers; light bulbs; microwave ovens; telephones or cell phones; batteries, smoke detectors, VCR's; DVD players; mobile radios; walkie talkies; air purifiers; CB radios; or any other item that is not a computer or a computer peripheral device. Non acceptable electronic items may be disposed of in the normal solid waste stream or the swap shop.

There will be no scavenging of computers or peripheral devices. If you would like someone to re-use your computer, please place it in the swap shop.
