A Program for Darien Seniors 60+ and the Disabled

Here's how the program works:

- If you're 60+ or disabled, you're entitled to purchase \$25.00 worth of taxi vouchers for only \$12.50 or a maximum of \$125 worth of taxi vouchers every month for only \$62.50!
- Just come to Darien Social Services in Room 109 at Darien Town Hall, 2 Renshaw Road to purchase your vouchers (cash or checks only). If you are unable to come to Darien Town Hall, call 656-7328 to make other arrangements.
- You must bring proof of age in the form of a driver's license, passport or social security statement. Proof of disability must be provided in the form of a disability statement from social security.
- After establishing age or disability, you may purchase and receive your taxi vouchers via first class mail. Vouchers cannot be resold or used by anyone other than the purchaser. Lost or stolen vouchers will not be reimbursed.
- Once you've joined the program, simply pay your taxi driver with your vouchers. You must bring cash in order to pay for tip and fare remainder under \$5.00. Taxi drivers will not give change for vouchers.
- Please note that **Eveready** Transportation cannot accommodate riders who need assistance getting into the car and cannot store wheelchairs in the trunk. Portable oxygen tanks and collapsible walkers are acceptable.
- Vouchers cannot be used for trips to the airports.

1. Use your taxi vouchers during the times when the Gallivant (655-2227) is not available (weekday evenings and weekends).
2. Go to dinner and a movie at the Darien Playhouse (655-7655), the Bowtie South Norwalk Regent (899-7979) or Tilly Pond Park (June – September).
3. Go to a show at the Darien Arts Center (655-8683 or <http://arts.darien.org>) or Sterling Farms Theatre Complex in Stamford (359-4414).
4. Attend the Darien Library's evening author series (655-1234 or www.darienlibrary.org).
5. Visit the animals and take a walk at the Darien Nature Center (655-3185 or www.dariennaturecenter.org).
6. Browse the stores at Stamford Town Center (324-0935) or downtown Darien.
7. Go to either of our beautiful beaches and have lunch at Uncle's By the Sound or bring your dinner and enjoy the sunset.
8. Participate in a course at the Lifetime Learner's Institute at Norwalk Community College (857-3330 or www.lifetimelearners.org) or at the Darien Senior Center (655-1705).
9. Do your grocery shopping in the early morning or late evening when you don't have to fight the crowds.
10. Use your voucher to go to church on Sunday or other church activity during the week.
