

### ***Can I get a certificate that says I am vaccinated?***

The Darien Health Department provides you with a card issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for your certificate that lists: your name, date of birth, how many COVID-19 vaccine doses you received, the date(s) you received the dose(s), and where you received it. ***Tip: Keep this card somewhere safe in case you need it in the future. You can take a picture of the card as a backup copy.***

If you did not receive a card or if you lose your card, you can contact your vaccination provider to get another. You can also contact the state Immunization Information System (CT WiZ) at the state Department of Public Health by calling (860) 509-7929 to request your Official Immunization Certificate.

The CDC vaccine card or the DPH Official Immunization Certificate can be used as proof of your COVID-19 vaccination. (see the DPH COVID-19 Vaccination FAQ at: [www.ct.gov/covidvaccine](http://www.ct.gov/covidvaccine))
