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

Darien Human Services offers a variety of services and supports to the residents of Darien. The staff has a wide range of experience and training in the area of Human Services and is available to assist residents by phone, e-mail or in their office at Town Hall and when necessary, in a resident's home.

Counseling Support, Initial Assessment & Case Management for families and individuals.



Information and Referral about other services that are available in the community, region and state to meet your needs.



Senior Resource Directory provides information about town, regional and state services available to seniors.



Darien Veterans' Service Contact Person serves as a liaison with federal, state and local agencies that serve veterans. Provides information, referral and support in helping veterans or their dependents secure the services and benefits they may be entitled to.



Municipal Agent On Aging serves as liaison with the Commission on Aging and other resources and programs serving the elderly.



CHOICES Counselor available to help understand Medicare Coverage, Medigap, Medicare Saving Programs and assist with the annual enrollment for Part D prescription plans.



Financial Assistance provides direct aid to eligible individuals and families with a specific need, on a short term basis.



Energy Assistance provides financial aid for home heating through a state program, the Darien Fuel Bank and Salvation Army to eligible Darien residents.



Renter's Rebate, a state program that provides eligible seniors and disabled residents with a rebate on their yearly rental expense.



Thanksgiving and Christmas Programs, helping eligible Darien families, children and seniors make their holidays a little brighter, with food, toys and gifts.



Back to School Program helps eligible Darien school children get off to a good start. Providing backpacks, school supplies and gift certificates for shoes or sneakers.



Household Supply Closet augments Person to Person's food pantry, with cleaning supplies, paper goods, and personal grooming products for eligible Darien families and individuals.



Loan Closet provides a free, short term, loan of convalescent equipment. Offering wheelchairs, walkers, canes, and shower chairs.



Reassurance call for the elderly or disabled who would like a call during severe weather or other serious town wide incidents.



Resource Library (located in the hall outside of our office) offers a wide range of information on Human Services resources and Health matters. Stop by and pick up a copy of any information you find helpful.
