#### Focus Areas

#### **Expand food scrap recycling:**

i. Sustainable CT is offering a community match fund grant with an application deadline of August 13th for food waste compost promotion. We are looking at different initiatives for viability for getting an application in, including having a video produced for town residents to inform them of the

program and how it works. Another initiative for a grant is to have residential home hauling of food waste and to subsidize the program for town residents.

## **Investigate leaf blower ordinance:**

ii. We are sending information to the town on an ordinance and what other towns are doing as well as scientific data on gas powered leaf blowers.
