The “Infiltration/Inflow Program – Flow Monitoring Report” prepared for the Town of Darien by Arcadis and dated September 2020, as well as supplemental Addendum No. 1 dated November 2020, have been reviewed by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP).

In accordance with the requirements of Section 22a-482-3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) as amended, the report is hereby approved. The report concludes that possible excess infiltration and possible excess inflow exist in the Leroy Avenue Upper, Mansfield Avenue Lower, Mansfield Avenue Upper, Mechanic Street and Stony Brook sewersheds. Further, in accordance with the requirements of Section 22a-482-3 of the RCSA, we approve the scope of the evaluation survey to determine the extent of excessive infiltration/inflow in the areas outlined in the report. This letter represents final approval of this document.


The evaluation survey must fulfill the requirements of Section 22a-482-3 of the RCSA and should be done in accordance with the EPA October 1991, “Sewer System Infrastructure Analysis and Rehabilitation” document. The survey report must provide sufficient justification for each sewer section cleaned and inspected as well as a specific rehabilitation program to eliminate all defined excessive infiltration/inflow. We emphasize that any costs associated with unjustified work will not be eligible for grant/loan participation.

A preliminary determination has been made that the proposed actions are consistent with the applicable policies of the Connecticut Coastal Management Act (Section 22a-92 of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended by Section 2 of P.A. 79-535).

This APPROVAL does not relieve you of the obligation to obtain any other authorizations as may be required by Federal, State or Local laws or regulations.
