Many people who misuse prescription pain relievers get them from friends or relatives,

1 in 5 high schoolers have misused prescription drugs, EPA studies have detected pharmaceutical drugs in our water supply from improper disposal.

Medicines play an important role in treating certain health conditions and diseases, but they must be disposed of with care to avoid harming the environment or others.

Sorry, we cannot accept liquid meds or sharps (needles).

Put sharps in an empty heavy duty plastic laundry detergent bottle, tape it closed & dispose in household trash. Liquid meds can also go in the trash.

**DO NOT FLUSH MEDS DOWN THE TOILET!**
