

Appendix E – Aquatic Program

Aquatic Facility Program

Description: An aquatic facility to meet the current and future needs and demands of Town residents.

Programs to be provided:

- Multi-generational swimming opportunity
- Learn to Swim Program
- Summer Swim Camp
- Adult Lap Swim
- Competitive Stroke Clinics
- Swimming Competitions (8 lane pref.; 6 lane min)
- Lifeguard Certifications
- Youth/ Toddler Aquatic Play Area
- Accessible Entry (Zero Depth Entry)
- Senior Aerobics
- Bathhouse to serve aquatic facility

Criteria to meet Aquatic Program**:

** Program assumes facility open to Town residents only.

Patron Capacity:

Main Pool Area: 6,000 sf = 240 patrons (*1 patron/ 25 sf*)

Splash Pad: 1,000 sf = 100 patrons (*1 patron/ 10 sf*)

Main Deck Area: 16,000 sf = 180 patrons

(Total Deck – Pool+Splash = Remain Area x 1 patron/ 50 sf)

Total Patrons (Maximum): 520 patrons

Anticipated Average Daily Patrons: 150 to 220 patrons

Parking Requirement: *avg. 3 patrons/ vehicle*

Total Parking Required (Maximum): 173 parking stalls (*Total Patrons: 520/ 3*)

Total Parking Required (Anticipated Average Daily): 50 to 75 parking stalls

Comparative Outdoor Aquatic Facilities:

Waveny Park Pool – Town of New Canaan

Main Pool: ~12,300 sf

Kiddie Pool: ~2,000 sf

Wolfe Park Pool – Town of Monroe

Main Pool: ~6,000 sf

Byram Park Pool – Town of Greenwich

Main Pool: ~6,300 sf

Kiddie Pool: ~500 sf

Splash Pad: ~1,000 sf
